Fight Cancer Foundation is committed to supporting families through the ordeal of childhood cancer treatment.

Since 1989, we've worked tirelessly to help kids fight cancer — establishing the Australian Bone Marrow Donor Registry in 1990 and the Cord Blood Bank in 1996, both of which continue to save lives through stem cell transplants.

A childhood cancer diagnosis places immense emotional and financial strain on families, particularly when treatment requires travel and long-term stays far from home.

Our purpose-built accommodation centres — BMDI House, just steps from The Royal Children's Hospital in Melbourne, and Hilltop, adjacent to Albury Base Hospital — offer a supportive home-away-from-home, helping families stay together when it matters most.
