Footy Colours Day fines





Introduce a little bit of fun at your workplace, group or club by incorporating Footy Colours Day fines into your celebration! A great activity to play if working remotely!

How to play

Set an amount of time you wish to play for (i.e. 1 week or 1 month) then create a list of actions people will be fined for (check out examples below for inspiration!).

Next, designate a Fines Master. For the duration of your game, the Fines Master will record the fines made by their colleagues/friends. The Fines Master can also hand out 'surprise fines' for any additional behaviour they deem worth a fine.

At the end of the designated time (i.e. 1 week or 1 month) the Fines Master will read out each fine received. The recipient of the fine then has to pay up a set amount to your Footy Colours Day collection!

For example \$5 per fine!

Example fines

- Someone gets photobombed by a family member during a video call.
- Someone attempts to speak with their audio turned off.
- · Select common phrases used in your office or group that are not allowed to be said.
- Ask everyone to stand up, if anyone is wearing pyjama pants or track pants they get a fine.
- Someone is late to work, gathering or a video
- Designate an 'illegal' colour (i.e. purple) if someone wears that colour during the game they get fined.
